






## ECCEASIA: more than 35 Taiwanese operators discovered the excellence of European olive growing



The second year of the project 'EcceAsia: the excellence of European olive growing in Asia', realised with the contribution of the European Union and aimed at promoting the excellence of European olive growing in Taiwan and Japan, is about to conclude its second year, not before having greeted the operators of the sector in Taiwan with an intense training event dedicated to them.

The Balance Meeting of the EcceAsia Project dedicated to Taiwanese operators took place on Tuesday 25 October. It was a remote training event, with connections from Italy and Portugal, which involved over 35 operators from the HoReCa sector, large-scale organised distribution, and journalists from Taipei. In fact, 37 operators took part in the training meeting on 25 October.
